Park Board: Terry Copeland, Dave Thurman, Robbie Tubbs, George Mitchell and Janette Guenther.

Staff: Kevin Boji, Ron Fowler, Dave Turner and Mary Ann McCormick

A quorum was declared present and the meeting was called to order.

Guests:

1. John Thompson and Angel Luna from Raytown Baseball Association gave us an update on league. They have 15 kids registered so far and open registration is now thru end of February. They are hoping to get 115 kids registered to break even. They have 5 parents ready to coach. A U12, a t-ball team and Mike Still has a team that want to sign up. In the t-ball league there should be 11-12 kids, machine pitch 12-13 kids and 10U, 12U and 14U- 13-14 kids per team. They are trying not to do fundraisers for the league to keep costs down for parents. John talked about the KC Water bill saying they thought Raytown Soccer Club (RSC) should pay for some of that water since they use the restrooms during the summer. Deffenbaugh same thing RSC uses the dumpsters.
2. Greg Walters and Delores Dewey talked about letter received from Kevin regarding not forming a committee but to join a neighborhood watch group. Greg says they already have a Neighborhood Watch group. Still would like us to cut electricity off to the shelters. Delores would like us to hire security for the parks. Terry Copeland thanked them for coming and will take it under consideration. There are social problems, police problems and noise problems and have taken steps to hopefully curtail the noise problems with a letter that was sent to everyone that rented a shelter house last year and people were told about the noise concerns when they rented the shelter house this year. Plan is set and we will wait and see what happens when it warms up this summer.

George Mitchell made a motion to approve the minutes from December 18, 2017.
Janette Guenther seconded and the motion passed.

Rice Tremonti – In 2017, they earned \$7000 in rental fees, have 4 rentals in January and 10 booked in coming months. Completed painting. March 17-18th Springs Soup & Crafts event. They are putting an article in the Spring City of Raytown newsletter.

Reports of Staff:

Director – a written report was distributed. Kevin stated BOA will put to voters in August a property tax increase to \$1 (per \$100 assessed valuation) and 2 cent gas tax increase.

Superintendent of Parks – a written report was distributed. Ron asked about putting new signage up at the parks. The ordinances need to be updated to 2018 verbiage before we do any signs. Need to check with city attorney about putting a sign up about “Up to \$500 fine for violating City Ordinances”.

Recreation Report – a written report was distributed. Dave is meeting with Raytown South High School about having the school team use LBTRA this spring until their fields are done. Will report back with updates. Green Space Committee-it was decided Dave would plan the events but would not need to attend them all.

Raytown Baseball – Since they paid their outstanding bill they are good to go for the 2018 season. Invite them back to the May park board meeting to give us an update.

New Business:

1. George Mitchell made a motion to install a Walking Trail at Southwood park per the 2018 Parks Capital Projects for approximately \$15,000 and have Kevin apply for a LWCF or RTP Grant. Phase 1 of walking trail would be as 8’ wide x 2” depth ¼” minus rock to include site work and soil removal. Phase 2 would be to install an asphalt walking trail over the 2” rock if grant is approved. The grants would be 50/50 matching. Any left over money would be used for benches, trash cans, etc. Robbie Tubbs seconded and the motion passed. Find out what Public Works does with asphalt millings for trail.
2. Dave Thurman stated that the Raytown Chamber of Commerce would hold a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for the fountain at Kenagy Park this spring.
3. Would like to schedule a park board meeting at Rice Tremonti this year.
4. Dave Thurman made a motion to adjourn. George Mitchell seconded and the motion passed.

- **Park Shelter Reservations**-2018 shelter reservations are now being accepted at the Parks Office, 5912 Lane. Rentable park shelters are located in Kenagy, Colman and Kritser parks for family reunions, birthdays, retirement parties or other activities. Full day and half day rentals are available. Shelter rental fees increased slightly over 2017. City Ordinances for amplified music will be enforced to reduce neighbor complaints. Shelter reservations can be made by calling 816-358-4100, visiting the Raytown Parks & Recreation Office Monday-Friday 8-5 PM or www.raytownparks.com for more information.
- **Parks Open Positions**- Interviews for the open Parks and Recreation Dept. Horticulturalist & Landscape Technician positions are underway this month. Qualified applicants can drop off an application at the Parks Office, 5912 Lane, Raytown for more information. Open positions are posted on the parks and city websites and area universities.
- **Raytown Youth Baseball**-Registration is underway for Raytown Baseball Association games at Little Blue Trace Park, 87th & 350 Hwy. More information is available by visiting <http://rba-baseball.website.siplay.com/>. The league welcomes pre-arranged teams and plays all its games at Little Blue Trace Park. Registration fees are \$85 per child. Raytown Youth Baseball operates the youth baseball program and is a separate non-profit organization not affiliated with Raytown Parks & Recreation Department.
- **Raytown Live**-Raytown Parks & Recreation is partnering with the City of Raytown and several community organizations to coordinate monthly downtown events at the greenspace. More details to come.
- **Pocket Park Rain Garden**-staff are working on plans to update the rain garden located at the Raytown pocket park (former location of Mugs Up Root Beer) at the southwest corner of 63rd Street & Raytown Road. The current rain garden will be replaced with an updated drainage system and a round flowerbed constructed with landscape blocks and two levels of decorative plantings.
- **Park Shelter #2**-A break in winter weather allowed staff to begin work at Colman Park Shelter 2 including removing old park equipment and updating the shelter with paint, installing metal gable ends and installing new shelter eaves.
- **Southwood Park Walking Trail**-On January 9, the Park Board approved construction of an 8' wide walking trail with rock at Southwood Park. The project will begin in the Spring.
- Ron Fowler and Alan Bancroft will be attending the Kansas Shade Tree Conference and education sessions in Topeka in February.
- For the safety of park visitors, "No Ice Skating" signs have been installed at the Kenagy Park pond.

Park Maintenance Report
February - 2018

Horticulture / Right of Way

We have made a formal offer to a candidate for the Horticulture position and it has been accepted. However, this is dependent on the candidate successfully passing background checks, a physical, a drug screen and references. Once this has been completed successfully, we will have a Horticulturist. My best guess is that we are a minimum of 3 weeks away from completing this process. More information will be available soon.

I am hopeful that the Horticulture Technician will be next. Applications continue to be submitted.

I am keeping an eye on ROW areas so that we can continue to keep litter/trash under control. Major cleanup work will still be a number of weeks off.

Park Maintenance -

Alan has been working on shelter house "fixtures" this month. Selected trash can holders are being repainted and repaired as needed and then they will be reinstalled back in the shelter houses. He will be rehabbing selected serving tables in the near future.

John and Alan have begun the prep work on Colman shelter number 2 for the installation of metal siding. The gable ends will be sided and some new trim boards will be installed. This is a small enough project that staff can accomplish, and will make a nice improvement to this shelter.

We were having some alarm issues at Super Splash recently. Upon research, we found that at least one time, a neighbor walked across the deck. Before this was determined, we found them outside of the pool compound and politely told them that there was a security system and that a trespasser, if caught, would be prosecuted. We have also installed "*NO Trespassing*" signs at the pool.

We have seasonally closed off the alcove at the Kritser bathrooms. It was being used for a bathroom and this makes it less likely.

Staff assisted in some of the removal of the Christmas decorations at 63rd and Raytown Road.

We have recently reattached some of the windscreens at the Colman tennis courts. It is not uncommon for this to be needed, occasionally, depending on the frequency of high winds.

John's wife, Stephanie recently had surgery. All went as expected and she is at home recovering.

Softball

We will start ordering equipment and putting together our registration information this month. I have met with Jerry Hinton of the 50+ softball group, and there is some controversy over the upcoming season with a dispute of a couple of players who are not happy with the Heart of America Senior Softball organization. The people and problem in question are on the agenda for discussion.

Raytown Youth Basketball League

Games have been going well overall, but we have had a couple of instances where we didn't get good coverage from our officiating team. Overall though, we have had quality people refereeing our games. The league will end on February 17, which will be our earliest end date since we started the league.

I do want to point out that our coaches have been terrific, and that their efforts are the reason that the kids are developing their skills and having a good time. I can't stress enough that their 18 weeks of commitment, sometimes to multiple teams has been tremendous to see and work with for the entire duration of the league.

Youth Baseball

I have been in contact with John Thompson, the current president of the RBA baseball group to help them with registration and their preseason game plan. The group still has not picked up their keys to begin their spring cleanup, and with the nice weather we've been having I would like to see them starting soon.

The Raytown High School baseball team will be hosting games and practices at Little Blue Trace Park, do to there being construction on their baseball stadium. They hope to be back at their own location in April, about the time the RBA would be starting most of the work at the park.

Dear Mr. Copeland and Members of the Raytown Board of Parks and Recreation:

My name is Dave "Bear" Barragan. I am a Raytown resident and an avid senior softball player, and I am writing to formally request to be placed on the agenda for your next meeting.

Being a Raytown resident, I have been playing senior softball at Sarah Colman-Livengood Park, in Raytown for several years. Most recently, in 2017, I played on and managed two teams at Colman; one on Tuesdays and one on Wednesdays. I have assisted several other teams to identify and add players to their rosters, in order to help them remain active and competitive. I have also assisted the Parks Department in finding capable scorekeepers, often at the last minute. Additionally, while I am not yet old enough to play on a 60+ team myself, I am currently putting one together. It is my plan to enter, and manage a team for the Monday night conference during the 2018 seasons. It is also important to note that, because I am willing to do everything in my power to help build the senior softball program in Raytown, I have had many discussions with current players and managers involved in the current conferences at Colman. In those conversations, I have learned a great deal about what the teams like about playing at Colman, along with their concerns, desires, and ideas to make our conferences function even better and grow even larger.

It is my understanding your Board will next meet on Monday, February 19, 2018, at 7:00 PM, in the Parks and Recreation Building, located at the entrance to Sarah Colman-Livengood Park. I, and several other interested parties plan on attending that meeting. I am the only attendee of this group requesting to be placed on the agenda at this time. Overview: Senior softball in Raytown, MO has existed for approximately 15 years. When the official program at Colman Park began, senior softball in the KC area was in its infancy. After a few years, there were two groups in the area, with both being relatively small. One group was organized at Colman Park and became known as Heart of America Senior Softball (HASS). The other group was known as the Kansas City Metro Senior Softball Leagues (KCMSSL). Since inception, the program at Colman Park has experienced some growth, along with a few struggles, resulting in 3 conferences and a total of 19 teams in 2017. During that same time, the KCMSSL has experienced tremendous growth. In 2017, they managed 12 conferences, composed of 76 teams, in joint coordination with the Parks and Recreation Departments of 5 different municipalities in the KC Metro area – and early feedback indicates that team number growing to 82 for the spring of 2018 season.

The Rationale for Change: Many of the participants in the senior softball program at Sarah Colman-Livengood Park, in Raytown, MO, have expressed a desire to become affiliated with the KCMSSL. The reasons vary from not having a voice in the current organization's Board of Directors, as to how their league and conferences are run, concerns relative to unfair treatment of players and teams, to the simple desire to save a little money in the process. In the end, the rationale for this change is that it will benefit all parties involved - specifically the City of Raytown. By being affiliated with KCMSSL, the Raytown Board of Parks and Recreation Department will experience greater earnings potential from the senior softball activities at Colman Park and the pleasure of working with 2016's publically announced largest senior softball league in the country.

The Future of Senior Softball in Raytown, MO: The future of the senior softball

program at Colman Park appears bright, if it changes its affiliation to the KCMSSL. Below are some of the main benefits of partnering with the largest senior softball league in the country.

- KCMMSL is an official 501(c)(4) non-profit organization and operates as such, in accordance with all applicable local, state and federal laws and guidelines.
- KCMSSL is fiscally sound and is willing to work with the cities where they operate, in order to best meet their financial goals and obligations.
- KCMSSL has a very active 13 member, membership-elected Board of Directors and 18 fully staffed committees, which allow players, coaches and teams the opportunity to address concerns effectively.
- KCMSSL is openly accountable to the host cities where it operates. Subsequently, these cities have had minimal concerns regarding their joint ventures throughout their existence. If an issue does arise, the cities know the KCMSSL will address and solve any problem with professionalism and expediency.
- KCMSSL has a history of generating growth for conjunctive Parks and Recreations. The city of Raytown's senior softball affiliation with them should be no different. If allowed to assume management responsibilities at Colman-Livengood Park, the KCMSSL will not only address current issues causing some of the teams to consider leaving, but I (Dave Barragan) am confident we can add a Thursday night conference, and possibly a Saturday morning conference.
- With the KCMSSL, the players pay an annual membership fee – similar to what HASS requires. However, with multiple venue locations, the KCMSSL's one-time fee allows players to utilize that single payment at a multiple number of the 12 conferences managed by the KCMSSL throughout the Kansas City metro area.

Dear Mr. Copeland and Members of the Raytown Board of Parks and Recreation:

My name is Gary Pumphrey. I met my wife of nearly 36 years, while living in Raytown and my in-laws and "adopted" mom are long-time Raytown residents. I retired after a 30-year teaching career in Blue Springs, where my wife and I currently live. I began playing softball at Sarah Colman-Livengood Park many years ago and have played senior softball at the park for the past 11 years. I am writing to inform your Board of what I consider to be "unacceptable conditions," and to express my support for a change in leadership for the Senior Softball program at Colman.

I'll do my best to keep this as short as possible, but I believe it's very important for you to have a reasonable understanding of at least some of the "unacceptable conditions," to which I am referring. For that reason, I will not share the details of many specific instances, but will instead give a brief overview of said conditions for your consideration.

Over the years, Jerry Hinton, the "director" of the senior softball program at Colman Park has, in short, bullied a number of people, and there have been numerous concerns voiced to the Raytown Parks and Recreation office over the years. Unfortunately, I am his latest target. When I brought his bullying to the attention of the Parks personnel, I was basically told Jerry can do what he wants and they have no control over him; "It's a Parks Board decision." If that is truly the case, I cannot imagine your Board wishes to be complicit in his actions, so I am bringing these things to your attention now. To start with, he has apparently told several people that he is banning me from playing at Colman. He has never told me this directly, but upon receiving numerous calls from friends telling me of his "executive decision," I have sent him email messages asking him to "do the right thing," be the man-of-God he claims to be, and encouraging him to quit being upset with me for leaving his team. He has yet to respond. Additionally, he has bullied my wife, other players, fans and even umpires. His bullying has ranged from telling people where and how to park, the imposition of rules made up in the moment, attempting to tell a manager he must get rid of players because his team is too good, interfering with an umpire's decisions on the field and a refusal to open up "the books" for the leagues or his own team. These are only some of the instances I have personally witnessed or verified with the offended parties. The problem is, Jerry makes all decisions regarding all aspects of the senior leagues, with no input from anyone else. He may have good reasons for everything he does, but that is not how "his" leagues are "advertised." The Heart of America Senior Softball website claims we have a Board of Directors, various committees and that every team is represented. Not only is none of that currently true as far as I can tell, but at our yearly coaches meetings, I have personally witnessed Jerry demeaning coaches


who dare to bring up suggestions for rule changes. He dismisses what the coach says and shuts them down completely. He simply says, "That decision has already been made and it's not up for discussion!" Sadly, many people are convinced there's nothing that can be done. So much so, that when an informational coaches meeting was being organized in mid-January, to discuss the possibility of presenting a request for your Board consider a change in leadership, Jerry apparently bullied and intimidated at least two managers into backing out of their commitment to attend the meeting. Additionally, at least 3 other managers, that I am aware of, did not attend the meeting, because they fear retribution from Jerry, in the event that he is somehow allowed to retain control of the park. Jerry makes claims about me being a disruption and trying to break up the leagues at Colman, when the truth is, I am personally vested in seeing the leagues at Colman thrive. In spite of all this, Jerry was more than happy to have me playing for him in 2016 and 2017, and he was all too willing to accept my "adopted" mother's money to replace the scoreboard at Colman Park a few years ago. Only after he realized he could not control me and had "accepted" the fact that I, and a few others, were indeed leaving his team to re-start our own team (Big Daddy's Donuts), did I become a threat to him and his team. That was when he decided I needed to be banned, which is most assuredly an "unacceptable condition" that needs to be stopped. I am far from the first person Jerry has bullied, but I certainly need to be the last!

I truly wish it had not come to this. I know Senior Softball at Colman Park is everything to Jerry and I acknowledge he has done a lot of good for the sport. But Colman and softball mean a great deal to a lot of other people too, yet Jerry has made it abundantly clear that he is not interested in sharing control. As a result, it is clear that his time in charge needs to end. I hope you agree and that your Board will look favorably upon the possibility of new leadership working with the Raytown Parks and Recreation Department to grow the sport at Colman Park. I am convinced that the time for a change is now and that the change will be a benefit to everyone involved.

Finally, I have been told that your Board will meet on Monday, February 19, 2018, at 7:00 PM, in the Parks and Recreation Building at Sarah Colman-Livengood Park. I and my "adopted" mother plan on attending and would welcome the opportunity to provide answers to any questions you might have. Ultimately, all I really want to see is the Senior Softball program growing to the benefit of everyone. I therefore, once again, encourage your Board to accept the coming proposal.

Dear Mr. Copeland and Members of the Raytown Board of Parks and Recreation:




Dear Mr. Copeland and Members of the Raytown Board of Parks and Recreation:

Questions regarding criminal activity in Raytown parks were brought up during public comments portion of the January Park Board meeting. In response to the request for information, Raytown Police and Parks staff compiled a summarized criminal activity report over the past several years.

The report consists of several parts. Part 1 consists of all reports for Colman Park going back to 2016. Part 2 consists of Raytown Police Department Incident Reports from 1/1/2016 for all parks. Part 3 consists of RPD Calls for Service from 2016-2017. It's worth noting that police activity does not necessarily equal criminal activity.

Additional statistical reports are also included. Detailed instructions for residents to sign up for Weekly Neighborhood Watch reports by park location are also included.

Part 1 RPD Activity Reports-Colman Park

Below is a list of all the reports I can locate from Colman Park going back to 2016. The incident Greg Walters referred to as happening in November is actually the robbery on December 3, 2017. It was *not* a domestic violence shooting. It was a drug deal turned robbery (they met to make a drug transaction and then one person tried to rob the other) and while shots were fired by one party, no one was hit and there were **no** injuries. I cannot locate an attempted suicide, but I would point out that that wouldn't be criminal activity anyway.

Per your request, I reviewed all incidents at selected City of Raytown parks for the last three years (2010-current). The selected parks:

Since the parks are different sizes, a more accurate method of comparison is to calculate a rate of the number of incidents per acre. This allows for a more true representation of the criminal activity for each park. As the chart above shows, Kenagy is the most "active" with just under 2 ½ incidents per every acre of the park. This rate, however, does not account for amenities at each park (such as the skate park at Kenagy, or the number of tennis courts, or length of the walking trails) which will have varying affects on the number of citizens who visit each park.

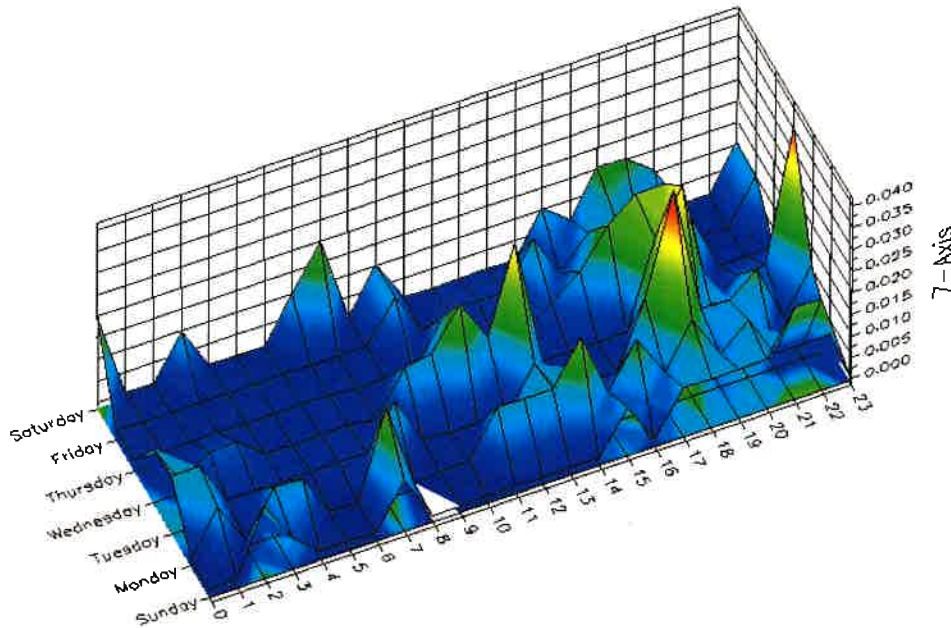
For the selected time period, there were 94 incidents reported on park property. The most common crime type is larceny in varying forms (including car larceny, auto theft, stealing and recovered stolen autos), which accounts for a third of all incidents. Criminal damage to property (vandalism) is the next common crime type, followed by drug offenses.

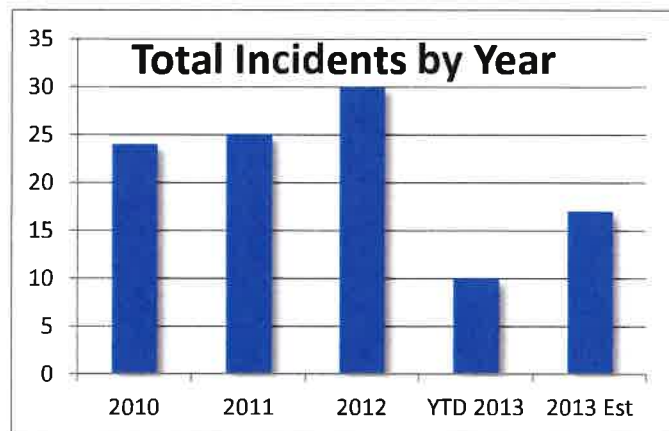

Over half of the incidents took place on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday and about 40% took place between 4-9 pm, after work and school. Looking at those two metrics together (day of week *and* hour of day), we can see that Tuesday evenings at roughly 6 pm are the “hottest” times for criminal activity to be reported.



When looking at the data by time of the year, the incidents rise, as expected, during the spring and summer when the weather is nicer and people spend more time outside. However, crime doesn't completely fall off during the fall and winter - it's just much less.

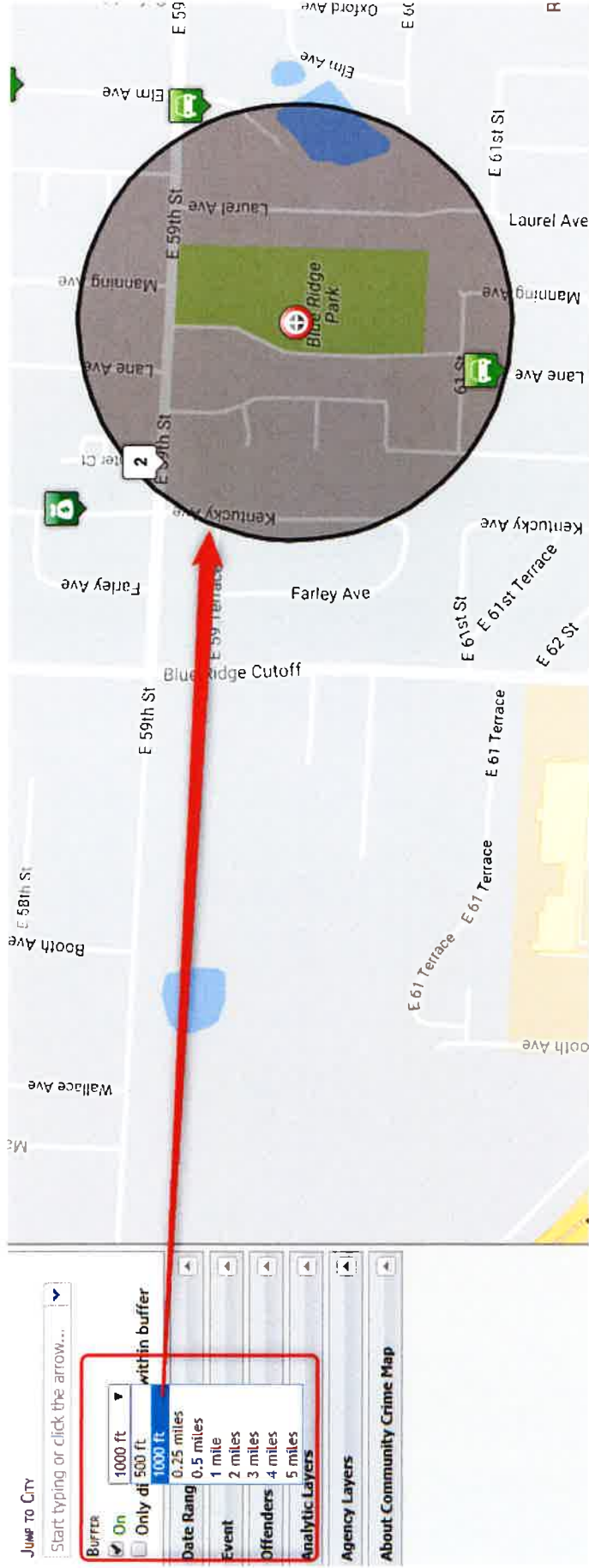
So far, this year, we've only had 10 reported incidents. That puts us on pace (*assuming criminals continue to behave at the parks as they have before*) for a little less than 17 incidents total. This would be a significant drop from last year, which had 30 incidents.



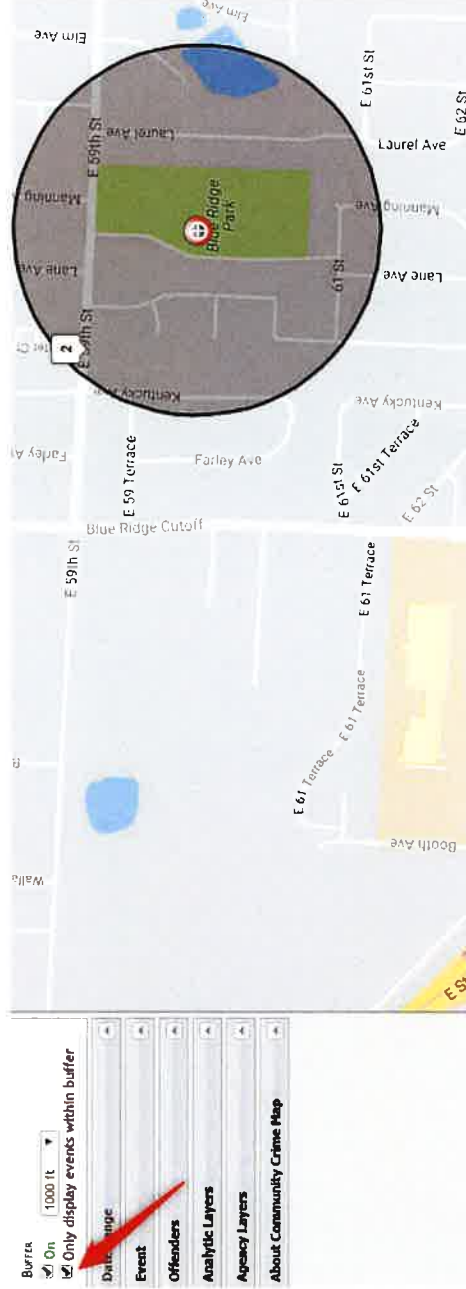
Community Crime Map-Viewing Crime near a Specific Location

To receive automatic notifications, you can sign up for email alerts. This is specific for each location, so if you want to be notified for each park property you'd need to fill out the form one by one for each location. Click the "Sign up for Email Alerts" button in the top right corner and fill out the box above. I would suggest a distance of 500 to 1000 feet and a frequency of weekly. You can check or uncheck the crime types boxes to choose specific crime types that you want to be notified of.
